Subject: Restriction on Use of Personal Vehicles by Students

Dear Parents,

Greetings from Chinmay International School!

This is to inform you that **students are strictly not allowed to bring or ride their own vehicles (two-wheelers or four-wheelers) to school** unless they possess a **valid driving license issued by the Regional Transport Office (RTO)**.

This policy is being reinforced to safeguard the lives of our students and to ensure compliance with the **Motor Vehicles Act, 1988**. As per **Section 4** of the Act, the minimum age for driving a motor vehicle is **16 years (for gearless two-wheelers)** and **18 years (for geared two-wheelers and four-wheelers)**, provided the individual holds a valid driving license.

Key Reasons for This Policy:

- 🚗 Riding without a license is **dangerous and illegal**.
- 🚗 It may lead to accidents or legal trouble.
- 🚗 Parents may also be held responsible if a child is caught riding without a license.

If any student is found breaking this rule, their parents will be informed, and the school will take strict disciplinary action.

We request all parents to support us in keeping our school environment **safe and responsible**.
