Pre-Primary Section

- Students will take the Rakhis home.

Primary Section (Grades 1 to 5)

- **Essay Writing:** *“Raksha Bandhan – A Festival of Protection and Unity”*
- **Eco Rakhi: Tie a Rakhi to Nature**
– Students will tie Rakhis to trees as a symbolic gesture of protection and care for the environment.
