- Maintain a regular sleep and meal routine.

Please DO NOT:

- Force writing practice.
- Compare your child with others.
- Scold children for mistakes or untidy work.

Assessment & Observation

Teachers observe:

- Listening and speaking skills
- Participation in activities
- Fine motor development
- Social interaction and sharing habits
- Confidence and classroom adjustment

There are no formal examinations or rankings in Nursery.

Suggested Daily Practice Routine

- 5 min – Conversation and storytelling
- 5 min – Rhymes or picture talk
- 5 min – Colouring or tracing activity
- 2–3 min – Praise and encouragement

Materials to be Brought Daily

- Practice books as per timetable
- Pencil colours / crayons
- Water bottle and napkin
- School diary
- Healthy tiffin

General Guidelines

- Label all books and belongings properly.
- Maintain cleanliness of books.
- Limit excessive screen time.
- Encourage healthy eating and proper sleep habits.
