Day 4: Rhymes Recitation

Recite 3 rhymes with actions.

Day 5: Picture Reading

Look at a picture and speak 4 lines.

Day 6: Counting 1–50

Count and write numbers 1–50.

Day 7: Number Names

Write number names 1–10.

Day 8: Shapes Drawing

Draw and colour 5 shapes.

Day 9: Story Time

Listen and narrate a short story.

Day 10: Opposites

Learn 5 opposites (big-small etc.).

Day 11: My Favourite Thing

Draw and write about it.

Day 12: Handwriting

Write 5 simple words (cat, dog, sun etc.).

Day 13: Good Habits

Write/draw 5 good habits.

Day 14: Matching & Sorting

Match and sort objects.

Day 15: Revision

Revise alphabets, numbers, rhymes, concepts.
